Comments: This is an excellent topic for students to learn about. I liked the fact the the kids realize they can't tell if something if poisonous just from looking at it. Look-alikes were very helpful. Presentation was wonderful. Visuals were great.

Outcomes: 6 mothers were surveyed two weeks after an education program. Only 1 had installed safety latches prior to the program, but 4 planned to install them. 3 put the poison sticker on the phone and 3 planned to do so. 3 moved poisons to safer locations and 3 planned to do so. 4 shared poison prevention information with others and 2 planned to do so.
