Outcomes

- N=19 public. Pre-test and post-test given after 50 minute presentation to teens at a high school for kids with problems showed a decrease in correct answers. Test question #1 showed 16 correct pre-test answers dropped to 13 correct and 3 "no answer" on the post-test. Test question #2 showed 13 correct pre-test answers dropped to 10 correct and 3 "no answer" on the post-test.
- 3 mother's groups (n=37) were given surveys one month after a poison presentation:
