Something to consider Chapter 30 Radiation Emergencies pg 429, the graph suggests adequate shielding for Beta particles is aluminum foil, though technically correct for a beta source, if the responder cannot confirm that it is a Beta and it ends up being a Alpha instead (which is possible in the prehospital chaos of a radiological incident), if they use aluminum foil to wrap or shield a pt who has been contaminated with Alpha particles it will generate neutron particles, alpha source + aluminum = neutron.



I don't think the course focused on the different roles enough. There were times where the course was in the perspective of a first responder. And then at other times, it was so high level, it was clearly more for the physicians.

The slides were not as helpful as they could be. Specifically, I think there can be better visuals distinguishing nicotinic from muscarinic receptors and their symptoms. The way it is visually presented, the slides highlight the similarities rather than their differences between the 2 receptors.

I would get input from toxicologists who have managed more HF and OP exposures. For example, intra-arterial calcium is never actually used any more, it's just mentioned in textbooks but is not practical or life saving. Also, the idea that you would waste time applying topical calcium to a HF burn with 50% concentration is absurd. There seemed to be an inordinate amount of emphasis on pralidoxime in this course. Not sure if this is AHLS bias or instructor bias, but all the toxicologists I have worked with consider it to be an optional and lesser antidote than atropine.




